



Student Safety Act Reporting on Arrests and Summonses

1st Quarter 2015

GENERAL DATA

There were 200 arrests and summons – more than 4 per day. There were 54 high school days and 56 middle school days during the first quarter of 2015 (January 1 – March 31).
